PARENTS' RESPONSIBILITIES CONTRACT

This organization is only successful with YOUR involvement!

- 1. CLASS ATTENDANCE:** Students must be at class and rehearsal in order to be successful. Any student missing more than 2 scheduled classes/rehearsals will be dismissed from the show. Any student missing a Tech or Dress rehearsal will be dismissed from the show. Show attendance is mandatory.
- 2. CLASS ATTIRE:** Theatre is very physical. Students must wear clothes that they can move in, roll on the floor, and be comfortable in. If a child is wearing a skirt/dress, shorts MUST be worn underneath. Please keep private body areas covered. Some classes may require a specific uniform.
- 3. SITTING OUT:** If your child is asked to sit out of a rehearsal/class for any reason (not wearing appropriate clothes, being disruptive to the rest of the class after 3 warnings have been given, etc.), it will count as a half absence. In other words 2 times sitting out will equal one absence.
- 4 HOMEWORK:** Your child will need help in memorizing their lines, cues, songs and choreography. Rehearsal time is limited and it simply won't be enough for them to be successful. THEY NEED YOU! Please review the script with them at least twice a week- more if they are having trouble. If a student does not have their part down by Tech Rehearsal, the director will re-assign lines, solos or sections. Talk with your child's instructor if additional help is needed.
- 5. PARENTS ATTENDING CLASS:** Parents are both welcome and encouraged to attend the first class day. We will go over the rules and reminders, then you can observe what the instructors and classes are like. However, after that, we conduct CLOSED REHEARSALS. Parents are more than welcome to wait in their cars or off premises. This rule applies to parents, siblings, friends... everyone. Parent volunteers may be on campus to fulfill their duties.
- 6. COSTUMES:** Parents are responsible for gathering costumes for their child for shows. We will send home an information sheet on what you will need ASAP when starting a new production. We try to make the costumes clear and easily accomplishable, but if you have questions, please let us know. Costumes must be finished and wearable by the 1st Dress Rehearsal. ***Under many circumstances we may provide costumes.
- 7. EARLY DROP-OFF:** Students may be dropped off 15 minutes prior to rehearsal/class time if there is staff present. The staff will be ready for them. Any time before that, the staff may or may not be present and will NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for them. Sometimes siblings are in different classes and parents drop off and pick up both at the same time and each child waits in the lobby while the other is in class or on stage. Students are more than welcome to do this, but again, the staff must be notified and are NOT RESPONSIBLE for those in the lobby.
- 8. LATE PICK UP:** It is the policy of this theatre that no child is left unattended, however, the staff is on a tight schedule and for any child left 15 minutes after the last class has ended there will be a \$10 charge. \$5 will be added for each additional 5 minutes. Payment is due next class/rehearsal.
- 9. TICKETS:** Each student will receive 2 free tickets to our major productions and 1 free ticket to minor shows. Additional tickets may be purchased as well. Tickets will be general admission for a specific performance.
